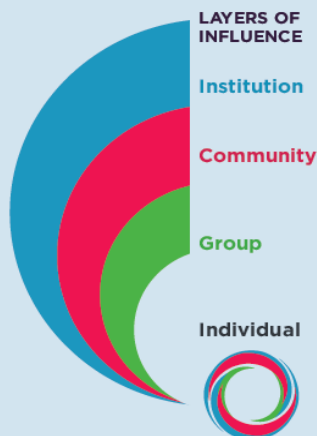

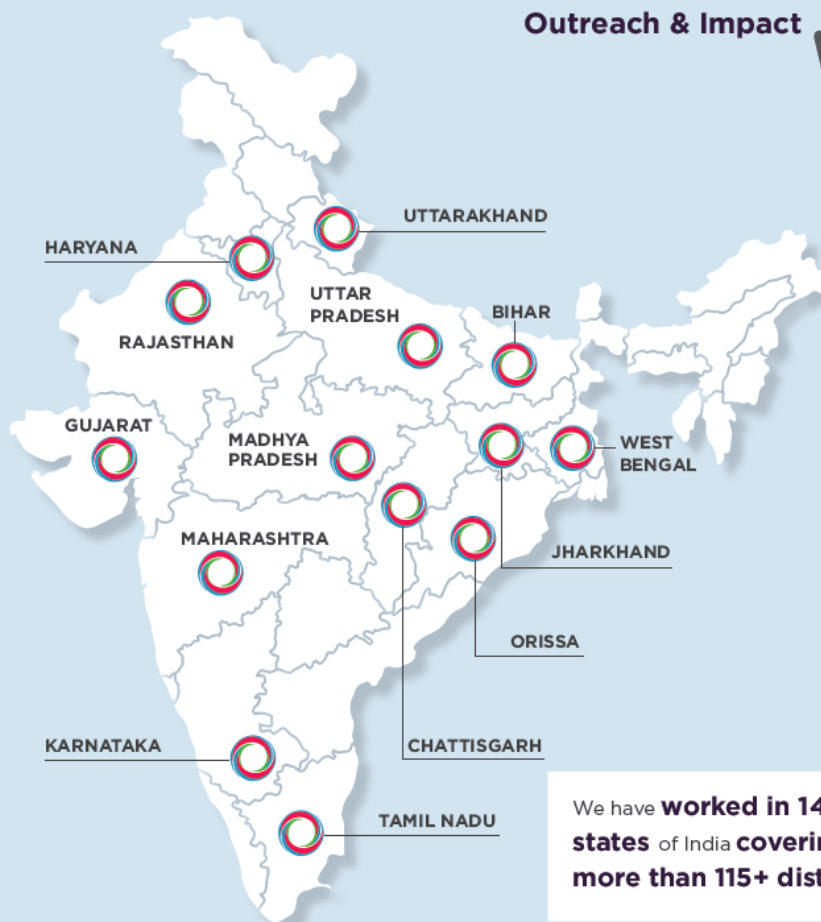

Our Accomplishments



Sustainability Action for Resilience and Advanced Livelihoods - SARALsamudaay - is SCORE Livelihood Foundation's flagship initiative. The programme was implemented in 7 villages in Vadodara district's Waghodia Taluka and 1 village of Alwar district. The program's objective was to build resilient communities with a focus on improving livelihoods and social infrastructure i.e. Govt. school development.

The programme outcomes are as follows:

Livelihood Enhancement

- 40+ women involved in stitching bags of Jute/Clothes and fulfilled local market demand
- 22 women & girls are involved in beauty & wellness training and services
- Group enterprises in Khakhara, flour and spices are created engaging 20+ women
- 65+ families opted backyard poultry farming
- 100+ women & adolescent girls are involved in different livelihoods with an average monthly income range between INR 3500 – 10,000/month

Health, Sanitation & Hygiene

- 500+ children, adolescent girls & women made aware on various aspects of health, sanitation, and hygiene

Community Institutions

- 20 Self Help Groups (SHG) formed and nurtured
- 7 existing SHG further capacitated to run and manage their institution effectively
- 8 SHGs availed cash credit limit from their respective banks to initiate livelihood
- 6 Bal Sansad formed and capacitated at primary schools

Capacity Building and Training

- Community resource person- 6 capacitated to ensure the sustainability of the interventions
- 250 women and girls trained on digital, financial literacy and legal awareness etc.
- 350 children trained on life skills, environment education, good touch bad touch etc.

Social Infrastructure Development

- Constructed Govt. Primary School at Hanumanpura village of Waghodia taluka, Vadodara district of Gujarat
- Renovated Sr. Secondary Govt. School at Belaka village, Alwar district of Rajasthan

Women Empowerment through holistic Livelihood intervention programme is about capacitating existing and potential women entrepreneurs to help them either start their individual/group enterprises or improve the existing businesses.

The programme was implemented at the following locations:

Ankleshwar and Jambusar block of Bharuch district of Gujarat

- Capacitated around 100 women on financial literacy, business ideation and business start up
- 61 women started their group and individual enterprises in incense stick, food stall, beauty & wellness, general store, restaurant, sanitation products manufacturing, papdi, varmi compost, vegetable selling, sari store etc.
- Average income of individual women is INR 3500-12000/month

Prayagraj, Jaunpur and Varanasi district of Uttar Pradesh

- 180 women participated in Beauty and Wellness Vocational skills followed by women agency building and enterprise development training
- 18 women started their beauty and well training cum service centre
- 37 women started homebased beauty and wellness services
- Average income of individual women is INR 2500-15000/month



Bokaro, Dhanbad and Giridih district of Jharkhand

- 400 women participated in Jute Bag making, Mop & wiper, Insence stick, tailoring and Beauty & Wellness training followed by women agency building and enterprise development
- 8women run training cum production/service centre initiated engaging 35 beneficiaries
- 22 women started their tailoring unit
- 34 women started their beauty & wellness service centre
- Average income of individual women is INR 1500-12000/month



Gurugram district of Haryana

- 200 women and girls trained on enterprise development skills followed by need based technical skills
- 120 women started their income generation activities using the new set of skills, knowledge and seed capital in the form of equipment.
- Average income of individual women is INR 1500-8000/month

A SCORE INITIATIVE

Financial Resilience programme focused on women to train and orient them on various aspects on financial literacy so that they are better equipped to use financial products and services judiciously. Financial inclusion is an integral part of the programme.

- 60700 women and adolescent girls were trained on digital financial literacy to inclusion
- Financial inclusion workshop, exposure visit to bank and post office was organized to expose beneficiaries about its functioning and available products and services.
- 1200 women and adolescent girls facilitated to avail formal financial services (Saving, investment, insurance, and digital payment)
- The project was implemented in the state of Odisha, Tamil Nadu, West-Bengal, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Delhi-NCR, and Karnataka with the financial assistance from SMFG India Credit Company Ltd and the Smile Foundation
- Women opted various financial products and services like Sukanya Samridhi Yojana, opened bank account, invested using Fixed Deposits and Recurring deposits.

Community Need & Impact Assessment

- Community/village baseline need assessment was done for the 6 villages of Waghodia taluka, Vadodara districts.
- Participatory Rural Appraisal, Household Survey, Focus Group Discussion, Key Informants Interviews methods were used to assess the overall community needs from the livelihood & income, health, sanitation, nutrition, education, skills, access to entitlements, social infrastructure, community institutions etc.

Fincare Impact Assessment

Rainwater Harvesting through Borewell Recharge, Koppal, Karnataka

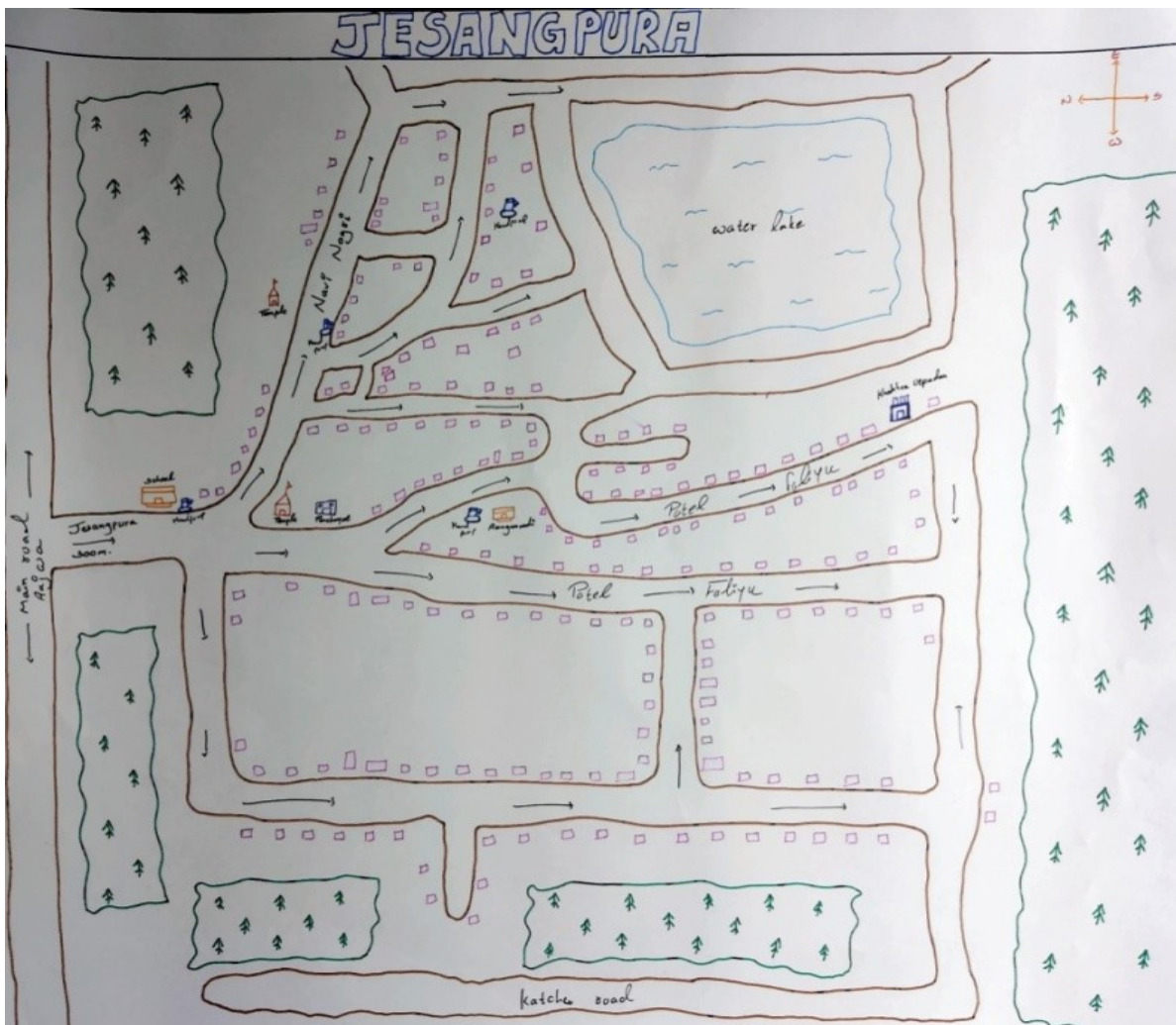
- SCORE Livelihood Foundation conducted the impact assessment to evaluate the success of the "Rainwater Harvesting through Borewell Recharge Project" in improving water resources and community resilience in Koppal District. The project focused on enhancing groundwater levels, supporting agricultural productivity, and sustaining livelihoods. The assessment involved monitoring borewell recharge impact, agricultural output, and community feedback to measure water sustainability and project effectiveness.
- The assessment revealed a significant improvement in groundwater levels, directly benefiting agriculture and livelihood sustainability. Community engagement and awareness about water conservation practices were critical factors in the project's long-term success.

Fincare Study Centre, Kolar, Karnataka

- The assessment aimed to gauge the effectiveness of the "Fincare Study Centre" in bridging educational gaps among underprivileged children in Kolar District. The program provided remedial education and emotional support to students, helping improve academic performance and social integration. The evaluation used academic performance data, student feedback, and community involvement to assess the educational progress and long-term benefits for students.

The assessment highlighted substantial improvements in academic performance and confidence among students. Community participation and tailored educational approaches were key to addressing the educational gaps in underprivileged children.

The SCORE’s annual event this year was organised in Rayantalawadi village of Waghodiya block of Vadodara district on dated 26th February 2024. In the event officials from L&T, Govt. officials, financial institutions, Govt. department like RSETI, SRLM, CED, media, academic institutions, Sarpanch and Talati around the villages, entrepreneurs and around 300+ community people from around 8 villages has participated.

The whole idea was to facilitate dialogue between industry, Govt., Academic institutions, development practitioners and community to bridge the information gaps and facilitate the required linkages.





Participation in World Sustainable Development Summit 2024, New Delhi

Mr. Madhuban Pandey was one of the panellists in the World Sustainable Development Summit hosted by The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI) in New Delhi on 8th February 2024.

SCORE had partnered with TERI in implementing a project on “Just Transition for a Sustainable Future in India’s Coal Mining Regions.”

The project was implemented in Giridih District of Jharkhand. SCORE had worked with TERI in piloting the livelihood interventions under this project.

The World Sustainable Development Summit (WSDS) is an annual flagship Track II initiative hosted annually by The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI) and it represents a cornerstone in global efforts towards sustainability. As a premier multi-stakeholder platform, it has for over two decades, championed the cause of sustainable development garnering global consensus on its criticality.



Interaction and Exposure Visit on Diversity and Sustainable Development for International Students

3 days interaction and exposure visit on diversity and sustainable development practices in India was facilitated for the students of University of Austria. 14 students along with their profession has visited SCORE's regional office in Jhansi to discuss and understand the various sustainable development practices implemented by the organization and beyond. The students had interacted with the communities, academic institutions, research organizations and development practitioners. From the diversity and culture exchange perspectives the students in the pair of 2 had got an opportunity to spent night with some of the families.




